Guidelines for Authors

All manuscripts are read by the **Editor** and by **two expert peer reviewers** through a **blind review process**. Each copy of the manuscript must contain a separate cover sheet including title of manuscript, name of author(s), institutional affiliation(s), running head, and contact information (mailing address & e-mail address) of the corresponding author. The first page of the manuscript should include the title only, omitting author names and affiliations.

While the particular focus of the Journal is on the Asia-Pacific region manuscripts from beyond this region are welcome, providing they have relevance to the readership. Emphasis will be given to research-based articles, approximately 6000 words (including abstract and references) that make reference to other critical work in the field and/or discuss particular issues of practice-focused research within the specific professional fields of health, sport and physical education. Editorial will privilege those articles that explore and provide a depth of understanding of the complex inter-relationship between developing/improving practice through the production of knowledge.

As well as our research focus we also invite manuscripts that engage in critical analysis and discussion of current events relevant to the key defining areas of health, sport and physical Education or contributions to workplace-based learning across a wide range of specific institutional contexts.

The review section will normally feature both book reviews (usually a maximum 1000 words) and review essays.

Manuscripts: Manuscripts of approximately 6,000 words should be presented double-spaced with wide margins. Label clearly any tables and graphs and include them on separate pages. All manuscripts must have an abstract of ~150 words typed on a separate page. Number the pages in the upper right corner beginning with title page, followed by abstract, text, references, acknowledgments if any, figure captions, tables and figures. Manuscripts should be submitted in APA style. Authors are encouraged to submit their manuscript to the Editor, in the appropriate format, via email. Do not submit the manuscript to another journal at the same time. Carefully proofread the final revision before submission, check the references for accuracy and retain a copy of the manuscript.

References: Each citation in the text must appear in the reference list as well. Conversely, each entry in the reference list must be cited in text. Names and dates must be accurate in both places. Authors are responsible for accuracy and should double-check the spelling of names to ensure consistency. Each entry in the reference list must be double-spaced and arranged alphabetically. References and citations must be in APA style.

Figures & Tables: Figures should be professional in appearance and have clean, crisp lines. Hand drawings or hand lettering is not acceptable. Submit one print of each figure and include photocopies in each copy of the manuscript. Identify each figure by marking lightly on the back indicating figure number, author's name, and abbreviated title of the manuscript. Tables should be on separate sheets and include a brief title. When tabular material is necessary, the information should not duplicate that in the text. Figures, Tables and their captions should be in APA style.
